Subject: Call for nominations for ITPA Topical Group members

At the 16th meeting of the General Assembly of EUROfusion in December 2016, it was decided that the membership of European representatives in the various ITPA Topical Groups will be henceforth limited in time to six years. Also a rotation schedule for the present members (whose mandate was not limited in time) was endorsed. The document that has been endorsed by the General Assembly is attached to this letter, along with the proposed rotation schedule of the present members.

As a consequence, with this letter, I now call for nominations for new members in the various Topical Groups. In interaction with all Topical Groups a brief document has been drafted (attached) that lists those competences that are most welcomed by the various groups, to complement the experiences that are already covered by the present group members.

Candidates who want to be nominated should submit, via their Head of Research Unit or GA member, a brief motivation letter, a brief CV of maximum 2 pages and a short list of five publications (only the list – not the publications!) that are most relevant for the position that is applied for.

Nominations should be submitted ultimately by Friday November 22nd 2024 to Richard Kamendje (richard.kamendje@euro-fusion.org) with copy to Karin Piller-Mutch (Karin.Piller-Mutch@euro-fusion.org). Since the ITPA members are representatives of the European fusion research community we try in general to have no more than one member from the same Institute in each Topical Group.

The selection of new members is done by the European members in the ITPA Coordinating Committee and the proposed new members are subsequently endorsed by the General Assembly in its December meeting. As EUROfusion, we are supporting inclusiveness and diversity and, therefore, welcome nominations of candidates from underrepresented groups. The new members will start their duty on 1 January 2025 for a period of six years. Please note that the call is also open to scientists from the UK.
